Born in Mexico City. Completed her master and doctoral degree at the Facultad de Filosofía y Letras the National Autonomous University of of Mexico. She has been professor of Art History, Modern Art, Art Criticism, Pre- Hispanic Art and Modern Art in Mexico, at Mexico's National School of Anthropology and Pre Hispanic Art at the National Autonomous University of Mexico. She has been Director of the Instituto de Investigaciones Esteticas of UNAM and the School of Art History at the Universidad Iberoamericana. She is a member of The Academy of Arts; the Mexican Committee for Art History and was its president from 1977 to 1988; the Latin American Art Association and is Vicepresident of the Comité Internacional d'Histoire del Art since 1979. She is the author of 12 books among them Escultura Funeraria prehispánica, Los Hombres de Piedra, Escultura Huasteca en Piedra, Peldaños en la Conciencia, Cabezas Colosales Olmecas. In 1989 she was conferred the National Prize of Science and Art. She is a member of México's Colegio Nacional since 1985
